PLEASE NOTE:

- All references to the Cambridge NY DMS10 switch are associated with CLLI code CMBRNYCMDS0 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.
- All references to the Albany NY Packet End Office (PEO) switch are associated with CLLI code ALBYNYSSPS0 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Verizon Cambridge NY DMS10 switch, located at South Side Main Street, Cambridge, NY 12816, will be retired and removed from the network after all traffic served by this switch is migrated to the Verizon Albany NY PEO switch, located at 158 State Street, Albany, NY 12207. All traffic to be migrated includes, but is not limited to, Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC/IXC), wireless, and paging traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers, and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Albany NY PEO switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that are code holders for access connectivity in the Cambridge NY DMS10 switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Albany NY PEO switch.

All ASRs for the Albany NY PEO switch must be received no later than January 15, 2021 in order to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. These direct end office trunk (DEOT) interconnections will support traffic migration for the Cambridge NY DMS10 switch prior to its eventual decommissioning. Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) change effective dates will be posted prior to decommissioning of the Cambridge NY DMS10 switch (on or after March 1, 2021). This will serve to guide interconnect re-routes of traffic for the one (1) native code currently served by the Cambridge NY DMS10 switch to reflect the Albany NY PEO switch as the new home switch. All ASRs for the Albany NY PEO switch must carry the project code of CMBRNYCMDS0.
