Description of the Planned Network Changes:

Verizon will make changes to its Signaling System 7 (SS7) network and services resulting from Alcatel-Lucent's discontinuance of equipment. The Alcatel-Lucent Signal Transfer Point (STP) located at 901 Tatnall Street, Wilmington, DE will be removed from service and the SS7 traffic will be moved to the Oracle EAGLE STP, located at 100 Greenwood Avenue, Jenkintown, PA. Also, the Alcatel-Lucent STP located at 4808 Leiper Street, Philadelphia, PA will be removed from service and the SS7 traffic will be moved to the Oracle EAGLE STP, located at 1050 Virginia Drive, Fort Washington, PA. All SS7 traffic to be migrated includes, but is not limited to, InterLata (Access/FG/CLEC/IXC), wireless and paging traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes:

SS7 service providers with SS7 link terminations in Verizon's Wilmington, DE and Jefferson (Philadelphia), PA offices will be contacted prior to the rehome to confirm use of existing link

terminations in the Jenkintown and Fort Washington, PA offices. Most carriers will not have to submit Access Service Requests (ASRs) because the rehoming will be completed using existing facilities to these offices. The following situations, however, may require ASRs:

1) Carriers may need to add additional links to the Jenkintown PA STP and Fort Washington PA STP if their existing links cannot handle the added signaling from the rehome. If these additional links are needed, the customer will be required to submit ASRs; and

2) After the rehome is complete, carriers must submit ASRs to disconnect their Wilmington DE STP and Jefferson (Philadelphia) PA STP links to stop the billing.

SS7 service providers and any other affected carriers will need to alter their SS7 transport, OffNet services arrangements (services obtained from third parties), and/or Gateway services to access or to continue serving customers served by offices that are currently homed to the Hyattsville MD STP and Southwest DC STP.
