PLEASE NOTE:

- All references to the Williamsville NY 5ESS switch are associated with CLI code WSVLNYNCDS0 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.
- All references to the Buffalo NY Packet End Office (PEO) switch are associated with CLI code BFLONYFRPS0 and will not be repeated throughout this notice.

Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

The Verizon Williamsville NY 5ESS switch, located at 46 North Cayuga Road, Williamsville, NY 14221, will be retired and removed from the network after all traffic served by this switch is migrated to the Verizon Buffalo NY PEO switch, located at 65 Franklin Street, Buffalo, NY 14202. All traffic to be migrated includes, but is not limited to, Inter-LATA (ACCESS/FG-B-D/CLEC/IXC), wireless, and paging traffic.

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact(s) of the Planned Change(s):

Competitive local exchange carriers (CLECs), interexchange carriers (IXCs, IECs), wireless carriers and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Buffalo NY PEO switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that are code holders for access connectivity in the Williamsville NY 5ESS switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Buffalo NY PEO switch.

All ASRs for the Buffalo NY PEO switch must be received no later than July 15, 2022 in order to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. These direct end office trunk (DEOT) interconnections will support traffic migration for the Williamsville NY 5ESS switch prior to its eventual decommissioning. Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) change effective dates will be posted prior to decommissioning of the Williamsville NY 5ESS switch (**on or after September 1, 2022**). This will serve to guide interconnect re-routes of traffic for the eleven (11) native codes currently served by the Williamsville NY 5ESS switch to reflect the Buffalo NY PEO switch as the new home switch. All ASRs for the Buffalo NY PEO switch must carry the project code of WSVLNYNCDS0.
