Description of the Planned Network Change(s):

Verizon intends to retire the remaining copper facilities in the following MA central offices: Ashland; Duxbury; Holliston; Hopkinton; Marshfield; Medway; Millis; Topsfield; and Wayland. Verizon plans to deploy its fiber-to-the-home network in these areas and intends to provide services over a fiber network infrastructure.

Description of reasonably foreseeable impact(s) of the planned change(s):

After the retirement of the copper facilities, Verizon will: (1) no longer offer services over copper facilities; and (2) cease maintaining the copper facilities.
