>>Andy Choi: THANK YOU FOR JOINING US ON "UP TO SPEED" THIS MONDAY, OCTOBER 25TH.TODAY'S EPISODE IS DEDICATED TO THE COUNTLESS FIGHTERS ON OUR V-TEAM, AND BEYOND, WHO ARE BATTLING BREAST CANCER.JOINING US TODAY FOR A SPECIAL CONVERSATION IS KATHY GRILLO, SENIOR VP ON OUR PUBLIC POLICY TEAM. AND WHILE WE WILL SPEND SOME TIME TALKING ABOUT KATHY'S ROLE AS A LEADER, THE FOCUS TODAY WILL BE ON KATHY'S OWN JOURNEY WITH BREAST CANCER. AND WE ARE SO GRATEFUL TO HAVE YOU HERE, KATHY. THANK YOU SO MUCH FOR JOINING US. >> OH, THANK YOU FOR HAVING ME! >>Andy Choi: YEAH. ABSOLUTELY. IT'S WONDERFUL TO SEE YOU.YOU ARE NOW A THREE-TIME BREAST CANCER SURVIVOR.

THIS IS A JOURNEY THAT HAS SPANNED MORE THAN A DECADE FOR YOU WALK US THROUGH THAT JOURNEY. WHAT WERE SOME OF YOUR BIGGEST CHALLENGES THROUGH IT ALL? >>Kathy Grillo: YEAH, SO I WAS FIRST DIAGNOSED WITH BREAST CANCER IN 2004, SO I WAS 35, WHICH WAS REALLY A SHOCK TO ME AT THAT TIME. I WAS SO YOUNG. I DIDN'T HAVE -- YOU KNOW, I DIDN'T FIND IT THROUGH A MAMMOGRAM BECAUSE I WAS TOO YOUNG TO GET TESTED, AND IT WAS FAIRLY ADVANCED THERE.

IT WASN'T LIFE-THREATENING, BUT IT WAS CHALLENGING, SO I HAD SURGERY, I HAD RADIATION, AND THEN FOR 15 YEARS, I PRETTY MUCH HAD CLEAR SCANS.I DIDN'T HAVE ANYTHING ELSE. AND THEN IN 2018, I WAS DIAGNOSED AGAIN. I HAD SURGERY AGAIN, AND I CHOSE LESS AGGRESSIVE OPTIONS THERE, JUST FOR MY OWN QUALITY OF LIFE, AND SOME OTHER CONSIDERATIONS THAT I HAD, AND THEN THIS YEAR, IN 2021, IN THE MIDDLE OF A GLOBAL PANDEMIC.

>>Andy Choi: YEAH. >>Kathy Grillo: AND REALLY AT A DOWN POINT IN OUR COUNTRY AND IN MY LIFE, IT WAS DIAGNOSED AGAIN. IT HAD COME BACK.SO THIS WAS A RECURRENCE FROM MY 2018 DIAGNOSIS. AND AFTER THREE TIMES, I MEAN, IT'S PRETTY CLEAR AT THAT POINT THAT THE ONLY OPTION IS A DOUBLE MASTECTOMY. SO THAT WAS A BIG -- THAT WAS A BIG DECISION FOR ME.

I HAD A LOT OF EMOTION AROUND THAT. >>Andy Choi: YEAH.
>>Kathy Grillo: AND, YOU KNOW, IT'S FUNNY, WHEN YOU TALK ABOUT
CHALLENGES, I ALWAYS THOUGHT ABOUT THEM AT THE TIME AS
CHALLENGES WITH A LITTLE "C." AND CHALLENGES WITH THE BIG "C,"
SO THERE ARE A LOT OF CHALLENGES WITH THE LITTLE "C"
MEANING THERE'S A LOT OF UNCERTAINTY. YOU HAVE TO FIND DOCTORS.
YOU GOTTA FIGURE OUT WHAT HOSPITAL YOU'RE GOING TO BE IN.
YOU HAVE TO FIGURE OUT HOW TO TELL YOUR BOSS AND YOUR
FRIENDS.BUT THEN THE BIG "C," THE BIG CHALLENGE, IS JUST THE FEAR.
SO SINCE 2004, SINCE I WAS FIRST DIAGNOSED, THAT WAS LIKE MY
WORST-CASE SCENARIO, RIGHT?

SO THE ONE THING EVERY YEAR WHEN I WENT TO GET A TEST THAT I WAS MOST AFRAID OF IS THAT I WOULD HAVE TO GET A MASTECTOMY .SO AGAIN, AT THIS TERRIBLE TIME IN OUR COUNTRY, AND A TIME WITH A LOT OF EMOTION AND A LOT OF CONFLICT, I HAD TO MAKE THAT DECISION.

AND HONESTLY, ANDY, I JUST SAID TO MYSELF, I CAN EITHER BE
AFRAID AND SORT OF GIVE IN TO MY ANXIETY, OR I CAN SORT OF TAKE
THIS ON AND SAY, IF I CAN FACE THAT FEAR, LIKE REALLY FACE IT,
NOT BYPASS IT AND NOT AVOID IT, BUT JUST FACE IT, AND TAKE IT
ON, AND GET TO THE OTHER SIDE OF IT, I COULD DO ANYTHING.
>>Andy Choi: AND THERE WAS GREAT POWER.c>> Kathy Grillo: AND THERE
WAS GREAT POWER IN THAT.AND I EVEN REMEMBER THE NIGHT
WHEN I MADE THAT DECISION, AND I SAID TO MYSELF, I'M NOT GOING TO

LET FEAR RUN MY LIFE.

I'M NOT GOING TO BE WORRIED ABOUT THIS ANYMORE. I'M GOING TO TAKE IT ON AND IF I DO IT, THERE'S NOTHING I CAN'T DO.

THERE'S NOTHING I CAN'T OVERCOME.AND I REALLY HAD THAT SORT OF INTENTION THE WHOLE TIME, AND LOOK, I DON'T WANT TO SUGAR COAT IT. I MEAN, THERE WERE TOUGH MOMENTS, AND A LOT OF DAYS WHERE I REALLY STRUGGLED, BUT MOSTLY, I HAD THAT END POINT IN MIND WHERE I WOULD HONESTLY LIKE SOMETHING HERE, LIKE SITTING WITH YOU SAYING, HEY, I REALLY -- I REALLY BEAT THIS.

I REALLY DID IT. AND I'M PROUD OF MYSELF.

AND RIGHT NOW, LIKE, I'M HEALTHIER AND HAPPIER AND MORE
BALANCED, AND MORE FUN THAN I'VE EVER BEEN IN MY LIFE. SO I FEEL
REALLY GOOD ABOUT THAT.

>>Andy Choi: WELL, NOT ONLY DOES THE POWER RADIATE, BUT JUST THERE'S JOY AND STRENGTH IN YOUR VOICE, AND IT'S AN HONOR TO EVEN HAVE THIS CONVERSATION WITH YOU.SO THANK YOU FOR SHARING WITH US.I KNOW A BIG PART OF SHARING YOUR JOURNEY RIGHT HERE ON UP TO SPEED INCLUDES GETTING THE MESSAGE OUT ABOUT PREVENTION, EARLY DETECTION.THE STATS TELL US THAT NEARLY TWO-THIRDS OF BREAST CANCER CASES ARE DIAGNOSED AT A LOCALIZED STAGE, WHICH IS A GOOD THING, NO SIGN THAT THE CANCER'S SPREAD, WHICH, FOR THE FIVE-YEAR SURVIVAL RATE OF THAT IS 99 PERCENT.

>>Kathy Grillo: YEAH, IT'S SO

IMPORTANT.AND I HAVE TO SAY FOR ME, IT WAS

IS SOMETHING THAT STAYS TOP OF MIND?

KEY. BECAUSE AT THIS POINT I WAS HAVING SCANS EVERY SIX MONTHS, BUT, YOU KNOW, SIX MONTHS PREVIOUS, I HAD BEEN COMPLETELY CLEAN, AND WHEN I WENT BACK IN JANUARY, THEY DETECTED IT.

BUT IT WAS SO EARLY AND IT WAS SO LOCALIZED, TO USE THE WORD THAT YOU USED, THAT IT WAS PRETTY EASY. I DIDN'T HAVE TO HAVE CHEMOTHERAPY. I DIDN'T HAVE TO HAVE RADIATION AGAIN. SO IT'S SO IMPORTANT. I MEAN, IT CAN REALLY SAVE YOUR LIFE AND NOT JUST SAVE YOUR LIFE, BUT JUST GIVE YOU QUALITY OF LIFE AT THE END OF THE PROCESS. IT CAN BE A VERY MANAGEABLE CONDITION, YOU KNOW, JUST LIKE YOU GET SICK AND YOU HAVE TO TAKE MEDICINE FOR THE REST OF YOUR LIFE, YOU GET SICK, AND YOU HAVE SURGERY, AND THEN YOU CAN THRIVE AND JUST FEEL GREAT ABOUT YOURSELF AND YOUR HEALTH. SO I REALLY, REALLY HOPE THAT IF ANYTHING, THIS, YOU KNOW, TAKES ONE PERSON OR ONE WOMAN WHO DECIDES, YOU KNOW WHAT, I PUT IT

OFF DURING COVID.I HAD SO MANY THINGS TO DO. IT WAS REALLY HARD TO KIND OF MAKE SURE THAT I TOOK CARE OF ME.

>>Andy Choi: RIGHT.

>>Kathy Grillo: JUST TAKE CARE OF YOU BECAUSE IT CAN BE THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THRIVING AND SUFFERING.

>>Andy Choi: YEAH.

AND THAT OWNERSHIP, ESPECIALLY DURING THIS TIME, IS SO IMPORTANT. SO HOPEFULLY THAT MESSAGE RESONATES. AND OF COURSE BREAST CANCER, CERTAINLY NOT JUST AN ISSUE EXCLUSIVE TO WOMEN, OF COURSE, AND WE'D LIKE TO TAKE A MOMENT NOW TO SHARE THE STORY OF V-TEAMER NEIL BREITENBACH FROM OUR ENTERPRISE TEAM AS NEIL REVEALS NOT JUST HIS CHALLENGES, BUT ALL THE WAYS HE FINDS STRENGTH IN THIS JOURNEY. CHECK IT OUT.

>> MY NAME IS NEIL BREITENBACH.I LIVE IN TAMPA, FLORIDA.
I'VE BEEN A VERIZON EMPLOYEE FOR A LITTLE OVER EIGHT YEARS.
I STARTED IN CAR RACING ABOUT 25 YEARS AGO, AND RACED FOR A NUMBER OF YEARS REGIONALLY AND NATIONALLY.

THEN ABOUT THREE OR FOUR YEARS AGO, I DISCOVERED CARTING AND IT REALLY SNOWBALLED FROM THERE, YOU KNOW, I STARTED COMPETING IN LOCAL AND REGIONAL EVENTS, AND EVENTUALLY MOVED UP TO NATIONAL EVENTS. GOING TO BE COMPETING OVER IN IRELAND FOR A WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP.

I WAS ORIGINALLY DIAGNOSED WITH BREAST CANCER 12 YEARS AGO,
BACK IN 2009. IT CAME AS A SURPRISE, AS ANY
MAN'S REACTION WOULD BE, IS THAT, YOU KNOW, IS IT EVEN
POSSIBLE FOR A MAN TO GET BREAST CANCER, AND IT REALLY ALL
STARTED WITH NORMAL ACTIVITY, SUCH AS PUTTING ON SEAT BELTS IN
CARS AND JUST HAVING A GENERAL FEELING OF DISCOMFORT IN MY
CHEST. AND, YOU KNOW, WAS EVENTUALLY DIAGNOSED WITH STAGE 3
BREAST CANCER.

AND THEN ABOUT FIVE YEARS IN TO MY CANCER JOURNEY, WE NOTICED SOME PROGRESSION OF THE DISEASE THROUGH NORMAL SCANS, AND I WAS MOVED TO A STAGE 4 METASTATIC BREAST CANCER DISEASE, AND WENT ON VARYING TREATMENTS OVER A PERIOD OF THE NEXT FEW YEARS.AND RECENTLY, THE CANCER HAS METASTASIZED TO, AGAIN, OTHER PARTS OF MY BODY THAT ARE A LITTLE BIT MORE DIFFICULT TO TREAT.

AND I'M CURRENTLY UNDERGOING CHEMOTHERAPY TREATMENTS.

I FEEL GOOD. I'VE GOT A GREAT MEDICAL TEAM. I CAN'T THANK MY

FRIENDS AND FAMILY AND COLLEAGUES ENOUGH FOR IS JUST THE

TREMENDOUS SUPPORT STRUCTURE THAT THEY'VE PROVIDED

TO ME THROUGHOUT THIS JOURNEY. YOU KNOW, THE VERIZON

COMMUNITY WAS JUST OUTSTANDING. MY MESSAGE IS, TRY TO BE

AWARE AND PAY ATTENTION TO WHAT'S GOING ON WITH YOURSELF AND

YOUR BODY, ESPECIALLY WITH MEN, WHERE WE TEND TO MAYBE

IGNORE THINGS WE THINK ARE SMALL PROBLEMS.

IT'S CRITICAL IF YOU KNOW SOMETHING'S NOT RIGHT TO SEEK

MEDICAL ATTENTION AND MAKE SURE THAT IT'S NOTHING MAJOR.
YOU FOCUS ON POSITIVE THINGS AND POSITIVE OUTCOMES AND STAY
INVOLVED IN YOUR ACTIVITIES, WORK, CAREER, WHATEVER YOU LIKE
TO DO.

I THINK THAT'S THE WAY TO GET THROUGH THIS, OR ANY CHALLENGE YOU MIGHT BE FACING, IS TO FOCUS ON THE POSITIVE AND NEVER GIVE UP.

>>Andy Choi: A BIG THANK YOU TO NEIL BREITENBACH FOR SHARING HIS JOURNEY WITH US.A BIG THANKS TO OUR PRODUCER. JESS BERNARDI FOR SHARING THAT STORY. WE KNOW FROM JESS THAT NEIL CONTINUES TO FIGHT, AND WE WISH HIM AND HIS FAMILY ALL THE BEST MOVING FORWARD. KATHY, THERE WERE MOMENTS IN THAT STORY WHERE NEIL SPEAKS ABOUT FINDING PEOPLE IN YOUR LIFE THAT YOU CAN LEAN ON. AND I KNOW THAT'S SOMETHING THAT YOU'VE DONE IN YOUR JOURNEY OF YOURS. AND I KNOW THE LINE BETWEEN LEADING A TEAM AND LEANING ON A TEAM CAN BE A TOUGH LINE TO NAVIGATE IN THE WAKE OF SUCH A PERSONAL CHALLENGE. WHAT HAVE YOU LEARNED ABOUT LEADERSHIP FROM THIS JOURNEY? >>Kathy Grillo: YEAH, IT'S SUCH A GOOD QUESTION, BECAUSE I DECIDED AT -- PRETTY MUCH AT THE BEGINNING THAT, YOU KNOW, I WAS GOING TO BE OUT ON LEAVE FOR A LONG TIME. SO I KNEW I HAD TO BE CLEAR AND HONEST AND TRANSPARENT WITH PEOPLE AS TO WHY.YOU KNOW, YOU DON'T JUST DISAPPEAR FOR 12 WEEKS AND NOT EXPLAIN IT. BUT I ALSO WANTED TO BE VERY HONEST ABOUT WHAT I WAS GOING THROUGH, AND TO REALLY SHARE VULNERABLY AND AUTHENTICALLY WITH THE TEAM, BECAUSE IN MY VIEW AND MY EXPERIENCE, THAT'S REALLY WHAT BUILDS TRUST AND CONNECTION WITH PEOPLE ACROSS THE BOARD, BUT CERTAINLY PEOPLE WHO WORK WITH YOU, BESIDE YOU, FOR YOU, AND SO I DID THAT, AND I GOT THIS OUTPOURING OF LOVE AND SUPPORT, ESPECIALLY

FROM MY OWN ORGANIZATION. I MEAN, PEOPLE SENT ME BAKED GOODS, AND I GOT LETTERS, YOU KNOW, LIKE ON LINES, YOU KNOW, PAPER WITH LINES AND PENS.

>>Andy Choi: HANDWRITTEN!

>>Kathy Grillo: YOU KNOW, PEOPLE

Still do this kind of stuff, and IT WAS GREAT, AND IT WAS BEAUTIFUL, AND JUST THAT KIND OF SUPPORT THAT I FELT.

I FELT LIKE BROUGHT US TOGETHER AS AN ORGANIZATION REALLY WELL. AND I THINK IT REALLY JUST PUT A CODA ON MY LEADERSHIP STYLE, WHICH IS I HAVE HIGH EXPECTATIONS FOR PEOPLE, AND I THINK I HOLD THEM TO THAT HIGH STANDARD. BUT I HAVE A LOT OF PERSONAL RELATIONSHIPS WITH THEM, TOO.

I REALLY CARE ABOUT THEIR WELL-BEING. I CARE ABOUT THEIR PROGRESS AT WORK AND THEIR DEVELOPMENT. IT'S SCARY.AND IT'S SCARY TO THINK ABOUT GETTING YOUR TESTS. IT'S SCARY TO THINK ABOUT WHAT HAPPENS TO YOU WHEN YOU GET IT, BUT, YOU KNOW, THERE'S SO MANY RESOURCES. THERE ARE GREAT DOCTORS. THERE'S ALL THE SUPPORT THAT YOU HAVE HERE AT VERIZON, OUR HEALTH INSURANCE IS VERY GOOD AND, YOU KNOW, YOU CAN GET THROUGH IT. SO JUST GET YOUR TESTS. PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE.
