Subject : Verizon Partner Solutions Industry Letter: Oakland NJ 5ESS Switch Retirement

PLEASE NOTE:

- All references to the Oakland NJ 5ESS switch are associated with CLLI code OKLDNJ01DS5 and will not be repeated throughout this letter.
- All references to the Rochelle Park NJ CS2K switch are associated with CLLI code RCPKNJ01PS0 and will not be repeated throughout this letter.

As set out in the Verizon New Jersey Inc. Public Notice of Network Change Under Rule 51.329(a), dated November 15, 2023, on or after July 1, 2024, the Oakland NJ 5ESS switch will be retired and removed from the Verizon network as part of ongoing efforts to modernize the network.

General Information: The Exchange Codes (NXXs) in Numbering Plan Area (NPA) 201 currently residing in the Oakland NJ 5ESS switch (see list in Table B below) will be moved to the Rochelle Park NJ CS2K switch (see details in Table A below).

The four (4) native NPA NXXs belonging to the Oakland NJ 5ESS switch will be rehomed upon decommissioning of the switch and reflected in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) for the Rochelle Park NJ CS2K switch. This will occur on or after July 1, 2024.

Network Changes and Trunk Rearrangements:

The Rochelle Park NJ CS2K switch will be the recipient office of traffic migrated from the Oakland NJ 5ESS switch. Traffic bound for the codes listed in Table B will be delivered via the Hackensack GT0 Tandem (HCKNNJHKGTO) and the Rochelle Park 06T Tandem (RCPKNJ0206T)

After all traffic is migrated off of the Oakland NJ 5ESS switch, this switch will be retired and removed from the network.

CLECs, IXCs, IECs, wireless carriers and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the Rochelle Park NJ CS2K switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that have direct end office trunk (DEOT) with access connectivity in the Oakland NJ 5ESS switch will be required to reposition the codes to the Rochelle Park NJ CS2K switch.

All ASRs for the Rochelle Park NJ CS2K switch must be received no later than May 20, 2024 to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. All traffic must be moved by July 1, 2024. All ASRs for the Rochelle Park NJ CS2K switch must carry the project code of **OKLDNJ01DS5**.

Please adhere to industry standards using normal procedures that pertain to updates and changes to the LERG for all NXXs subject to the retirement of the Oakland NJ 5ESS switch.
