## Subject : Verizon Partner Solutions Industry Letter: Changes to Shared Use for Interstate Services in Verizon FCC Tariffs and Business Data Services (BDS) Product Guide

Effective immediately, Verizon[1] has modified shared use under the BDS Product Guide. Verizon is also filing at the FCC, under Transmittal 1444, tariff revisions modifying shared use in Verizons FCC Tariff Nos. 1, 11, 14 and 16 for effect on June 5, 2024.

A Shared Use facility will be ordered, provisioned and rated only as Special Access Service, regardless of whether individual channels of the Shared Use facility are used for Special Access Service, Switched Access Service, or any other type of service. The practice known as ratcheting (to apply non-Special Access rates on a proportional basis) shall not apply in any circumstances. Further terms and conditions apply as set forth in the above-referenced revisions to the BDS Product Guide and tariffs.
