Subject : Verizon Partner Solutions Industry Letter: Washington NJ DMS100 Switch Retirement

PLEASE NOTE:

- All references to the Washington NJ DMS100 switch are associated with CLLI code WASHNJWADS5 and will not be repeated throughout this letter.
- •All references to the New Brunswick NJ C20 switch are associated with CLLI code NBWKNJNBPS2 and will not be repeated throughout this letter.

As set out in the Verizon New Jersey Inc. Public Notice of Network Change Under Rule 51.329(a), dated August 30, 2024, on or after March 1, 2025, the Washington NJ DMS100 switch will be retired and removed from the Verizon network as part of ongoing efforts to modernize the network.

General Information: The Exchange Codes (NXXs) in Numbering Plan Area (NPA) 908 currently residing in the Washington NJ DMS100 switch (see list in Table B below) will be moved to the New Brunswick NJ C20 switch (see details in Table A below).

The two (2) native NPA NXXs belonging to the Washington NJ DMS100 switch will be rehomed upon decommissioning of the switch and reflected in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) for the New Brunswick NJ C20 switch. This will occur on or after March 1, 2025.

Network Changes and Trunk Rearrangements:

The New Brunswick NJ C20 switch will be the recipient office of traffic migrated from the Washington NJ DMS100 switch. Traffic bound for the codes listed in Table B will be delivered via the New Brunswick 04T Tandem (NBWKNJNB04T).

After all traffic is migrated off of the Washington NJ DMS100 switch, this switch will be retired and removed from the network.

CLECs, IXCs, IECs, wireless carriers and paging carriers will need to secure new trunk groups built to the New Brunswick NJ C20 switch or have existing trunk groups to that switch augmented. Carriers that have direct end office trunk (DEOT) with access connectivity in the Washington NJ DMS100 switch will be required to reposition the codes to the New Brunswick NJ C20 switch.

All ASRs for the New Brunswick NJ C20 switch must be received no later than January 23, 2025, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. All traffic must be moved by March 1, 2025. All ASRs for the New Brunswick NJ C20

switch must carry the project code of WASHNJWADS5.

Please adhere to industry standards using normal procedures that pertain to updates and changes to the LERG for all NXXs subject to the retirement of the Washington NJ DMS100 switch.
