

We're pleased to announce exciting changes coming to the Verizon Partner Solutions Exchange. This upgrade will take effect on August 21, 2022.

Release Highlights

Fiber-to-the-Internet (FTTI) & Nationwide Business Internet

- Support disconnect orders for FTTI service in the Verizon Partner Solution Exchange portal.
- For locations not supported by FTTI, Nationwide Business Internet 4G or 5G fixed wireless access availability check will be presented.

Internationally-Served Switched E-Line (UNI-EVC combo) and Internet Dedicated +

- Introduce quote to order for these products at service locations outside of the United States. This will only be supported with the multi-location quoting function.
- For Switched E-Line, an NNI/Hub will have to be provided for a service configuration outside the US.

More Products

- Switched E-Line (EVPL NNI Stand-alone): Quote to order for this product offering.
- Private Line (MPL, USPL, DAL) and VzB non-optimized for PIP and Wave: Ordering of these products.

Ordering Enhancement

• **Wave OWS**: Quote Authorized (QA) field will be added to give Verizon the authorization to provide a quote that may include special construction costs if needed. The user can choose to deselect this option.

Change Service

- **Change requests** are introduced for Switched E-Line/EVPL, TLS, Dedicated E-Line, VZON, Internet, Private IP, Wave and OWS products for the scenarios supported in Verizon Partner Solutions Exchange. Move requests are also supported as applicable to the above products. This is available as of July 18th.
- **Disconnect requests** will support an expanded retrieval of circuit data, including services that were not ordered via Verizon Partner Solutions Exchange (e.g., DS1). This excludes services with meetpoint or local transport configurations.

Create Repair Ticket Enhancement

• Enhance the service ID match results with an expanded inventory option, which a user can select if there is no match from the initial search, in order to proceed with a ticket submission.

Set Up and Contracting Automation

• Introduce the capability to view a contract inventory listing in Verizon Partner Solutions Exchange and the ability to request a new contract.
