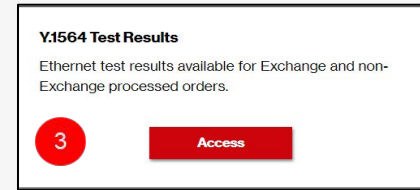
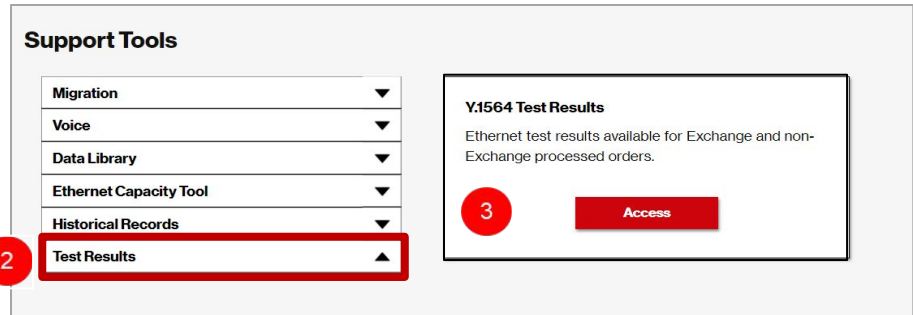

5. Download the test results.

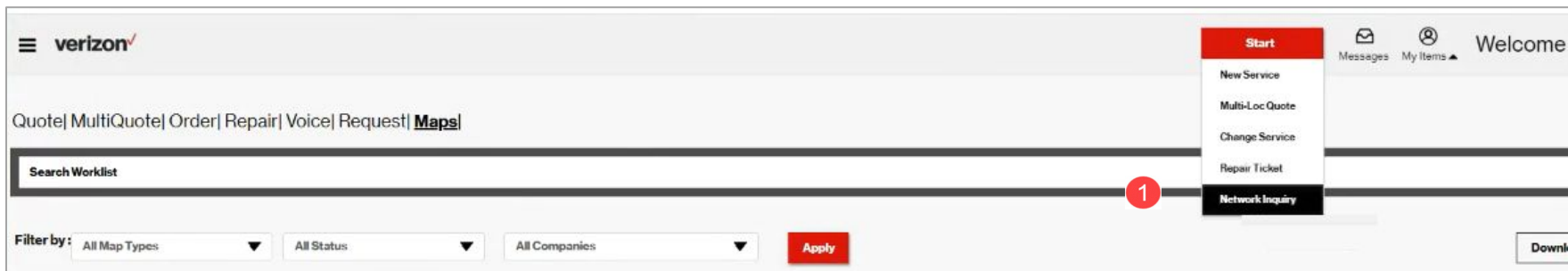



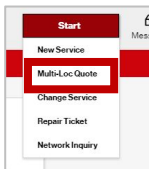

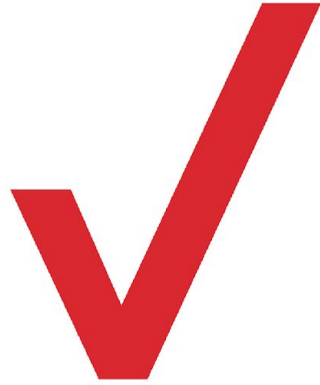
