To search for a particular word in a document, type the word in the Search For box.




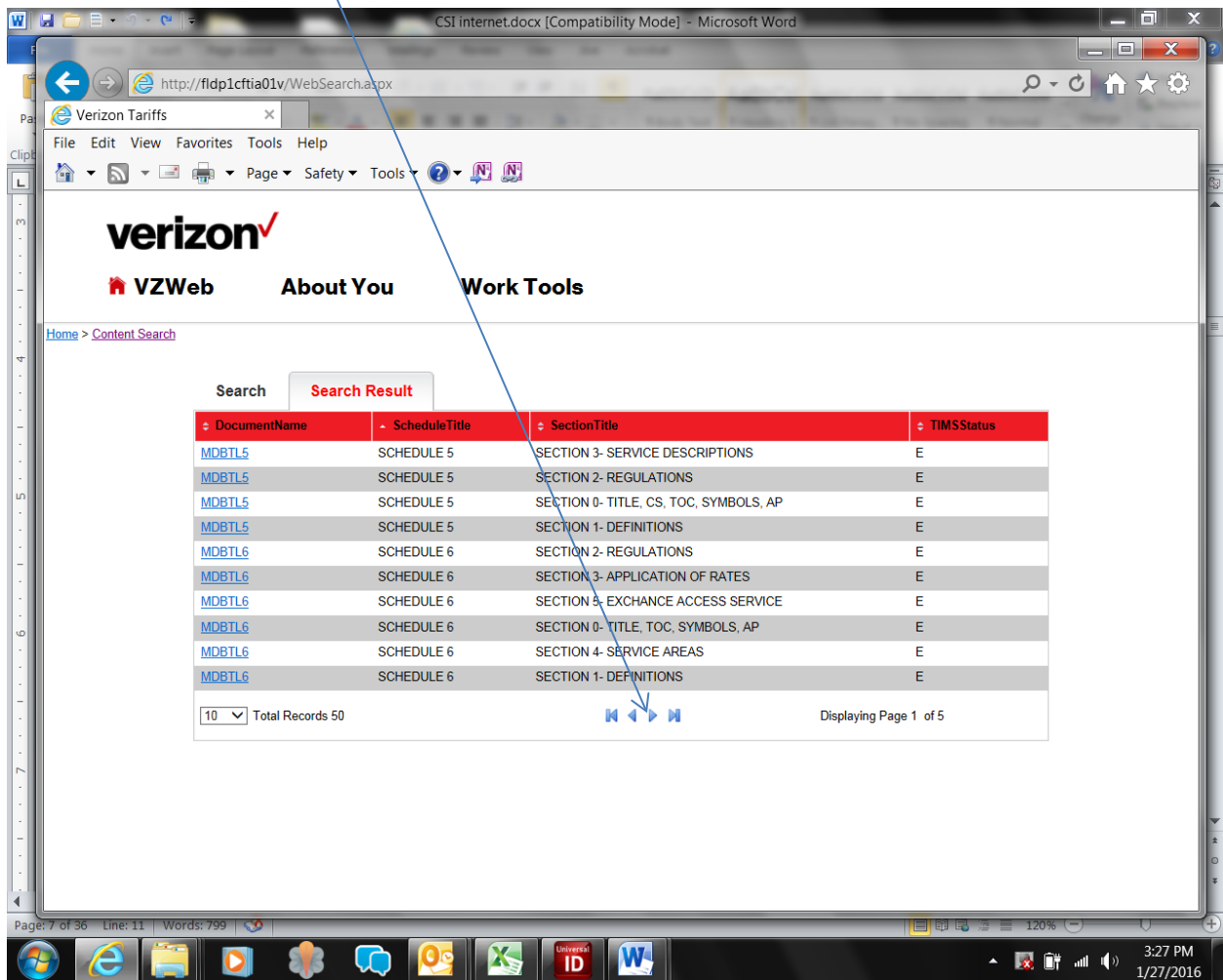

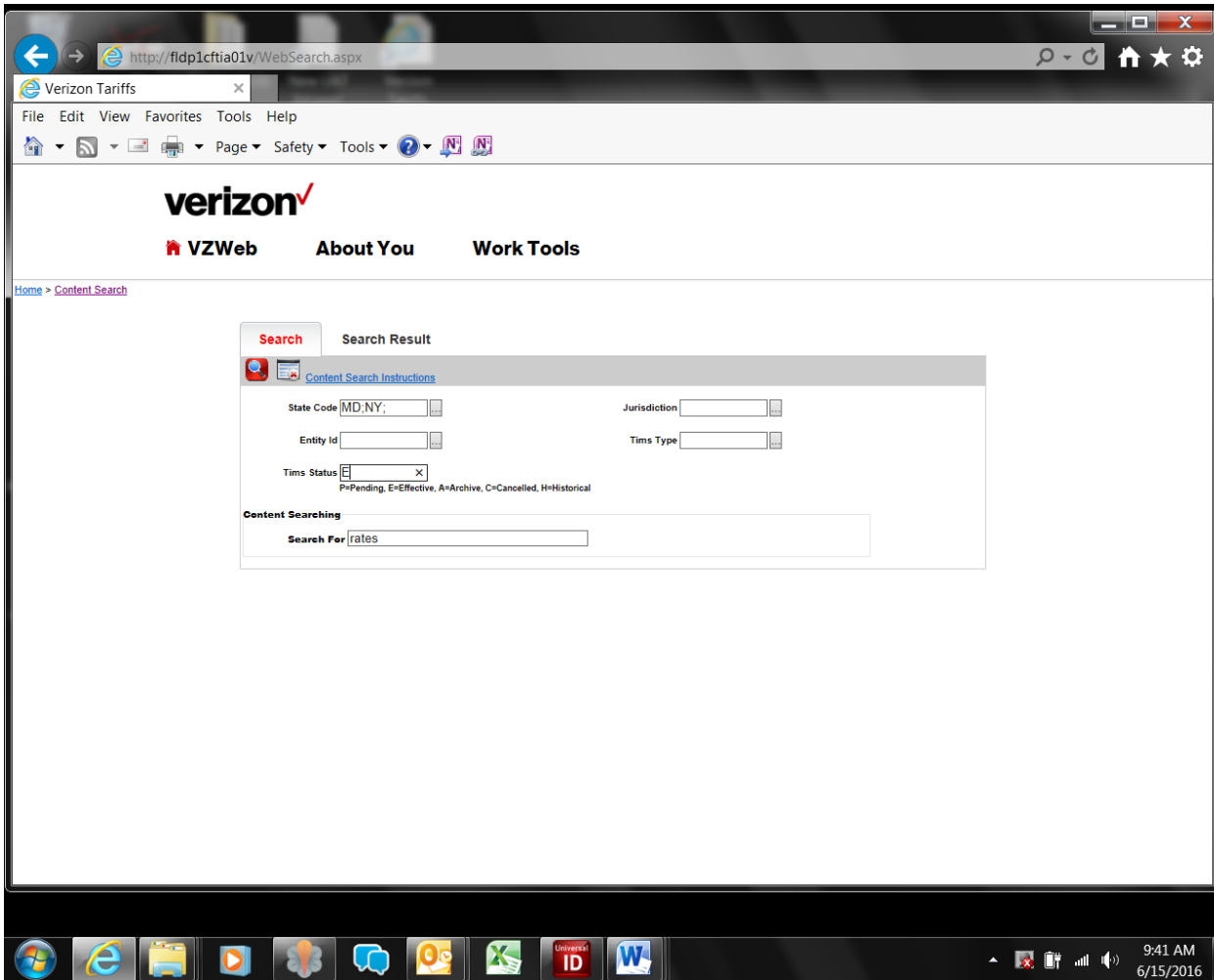
Example: Selecting Content Search from MD State Web Page – specify state MD

TIPS ON USING SEARCH

Other tips that may help return the most accurate search results:

Narrow your search. Narrow your search by linking them with AND and the search engine will find pages containing all the keywords. (see Example 1)

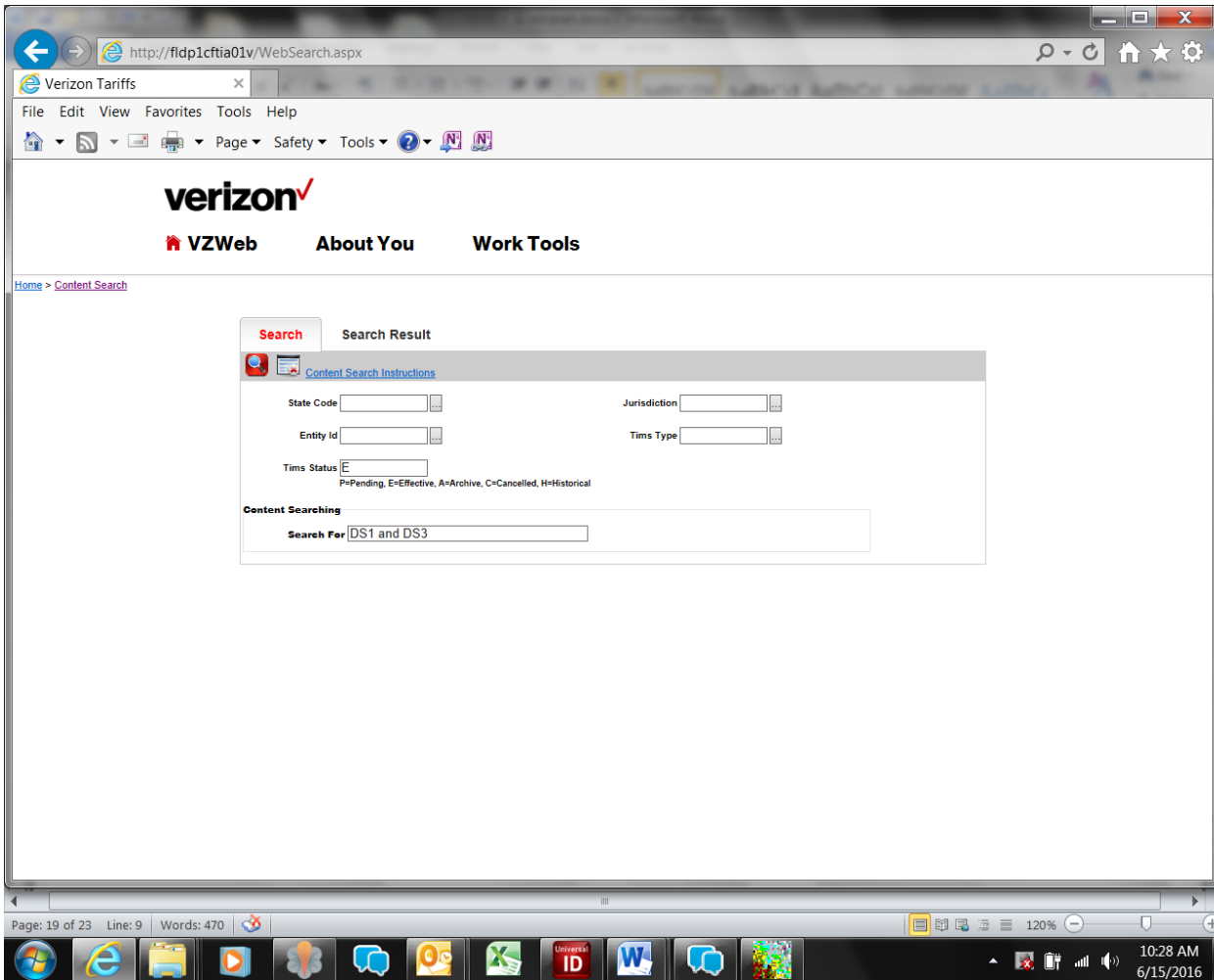
Expand your search. Expand your search by linking keywords with OR and the search engine will find pages with at least one of the keywords. (see Example 2)

Double quotations: Enclosing a word with double quotations marks (see Example 3)

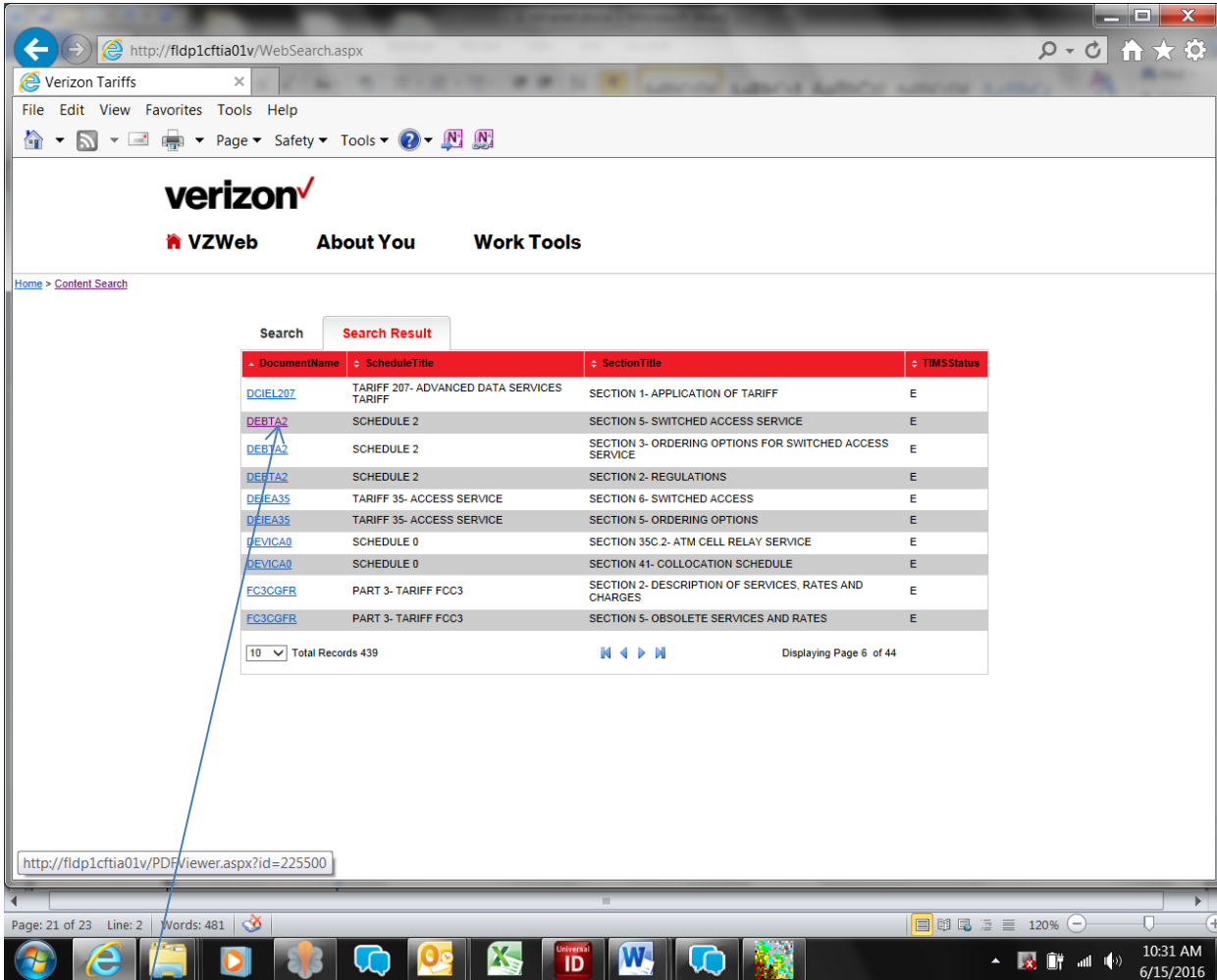

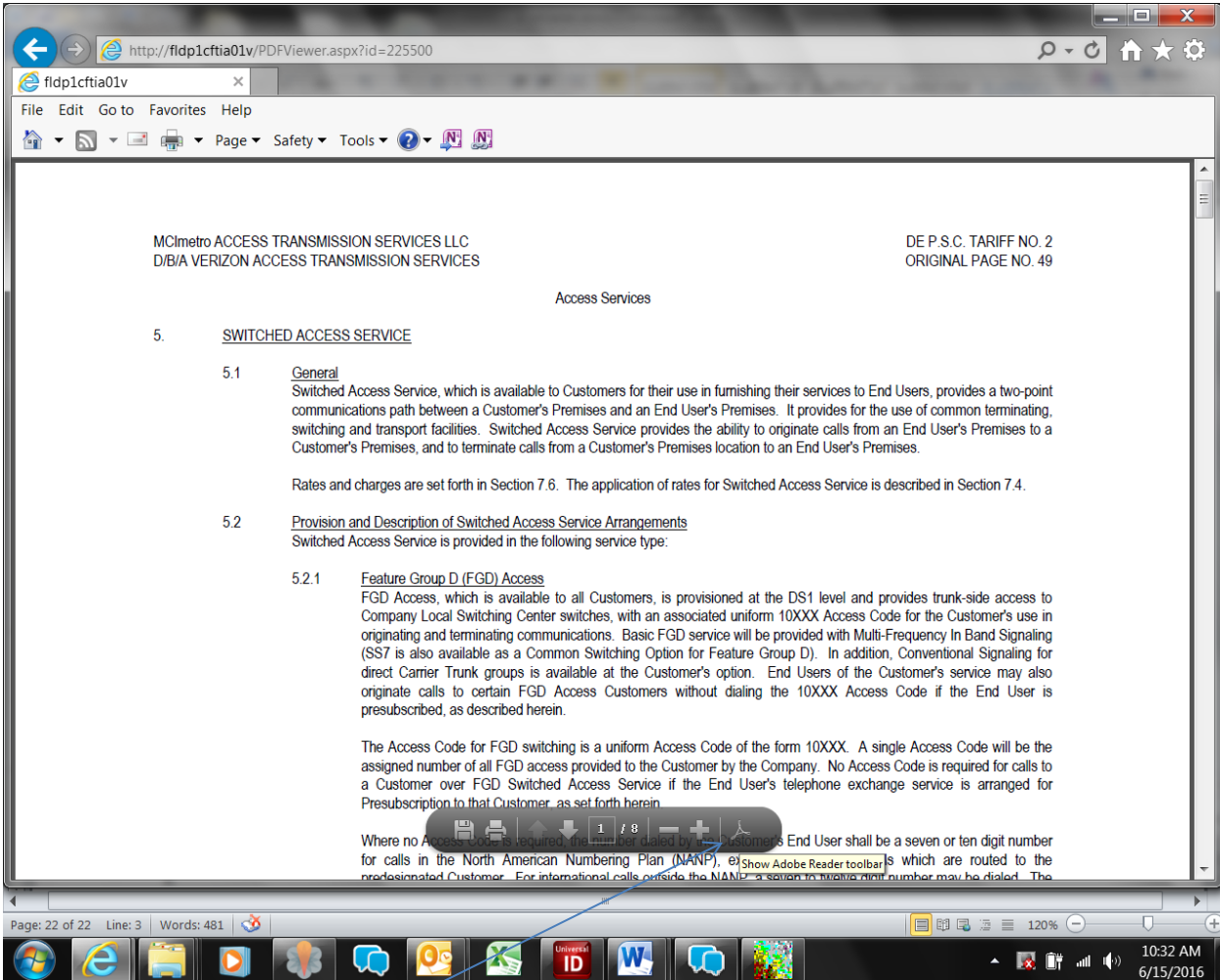

Access Services

5. SWITCHED ACCESS SERVICE

5.1 General
Switched Access Service, which is available to Customers for their use in furnishing their services to End Users, provides a two-point communications path between a Customer's Premises and an End User's Premises. It provides for the use of common terminating, switching and transport facilities. Switched Access Service provides the ability to originate calls from an End User's Premises to a Customer's Premises, and to terminate calls from a Customer's Premises location to an End User's Premises.

Rates and charges are set forth in Section 7.6. The application of rates for Switched Access Service is described in Section 7.4.

5.2 Provision and Description of Switched Access Service Arrangements
Switched Access Service is provided in the following service type:

5.2.1 Feature Group D (FGD) Access
FGD Access, which is available to all Customers, is provisioned at the DS1 level and provides trunk-side access to Company Local Switching Center switches, with an associated uniform 10XXX Access Code for the Customer's use in originating and terminating communications. Basic FGD service will be provided with Multi-Frequency In Band Signaling (SS7 is also available as a Common Switching Option for Feature Group D). In addition, Conventional Signaling for direct Carrier Trunk groups is available at the Customer's option. End Users of the Customer's service may also originate calls to certain FGD Access Customers without dialing the 10XXX Access Code if the End User is presubscribed, as described herein.

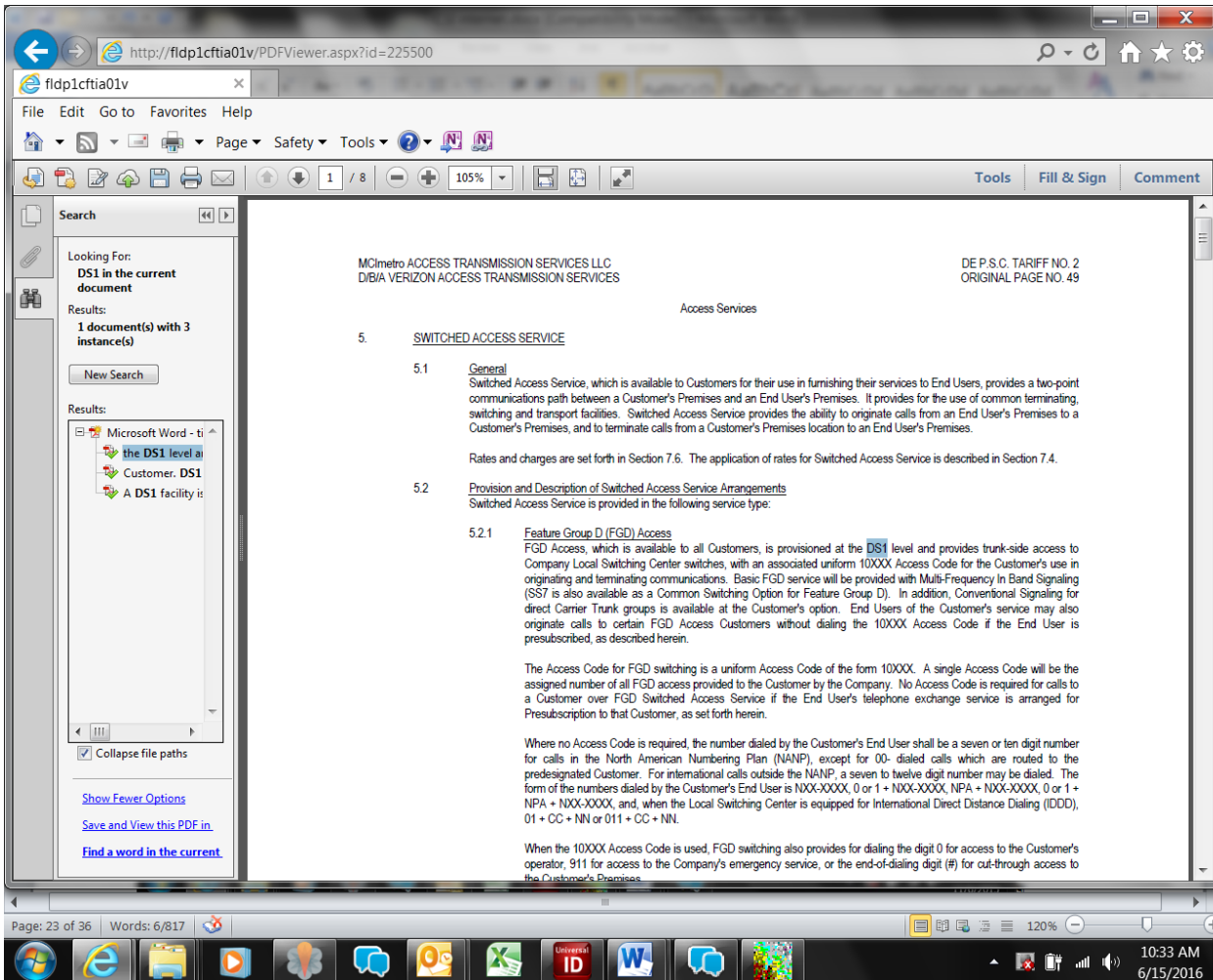
The Access Code for FGD switching is a uniform Access Code of the form 10XXX. A single Access Code will be the assigned number of all FGD access provided to the Customer by the Company. No Access Code is required for calls to a Customer over FGD Switched Access Service if the End User's telephone exchange service is arranged for Presubscription to that Customer, as set forth herein.

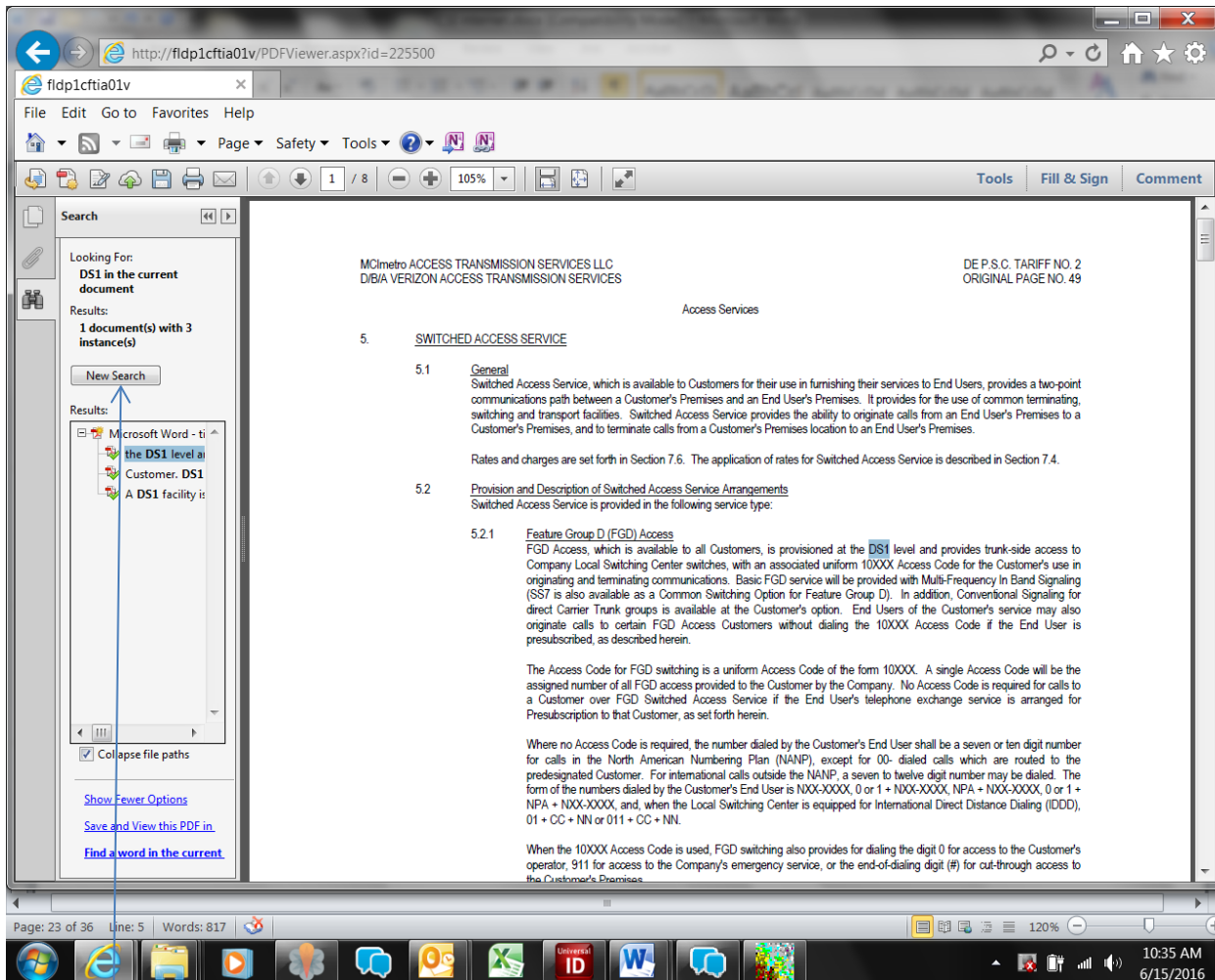
Where no Access Code is required, the number dialed by the Customer's End User shall be a seven or ten digit number for calls in the North American Numbering Plan (NANP), except for 00- dialed calls which are routed to the

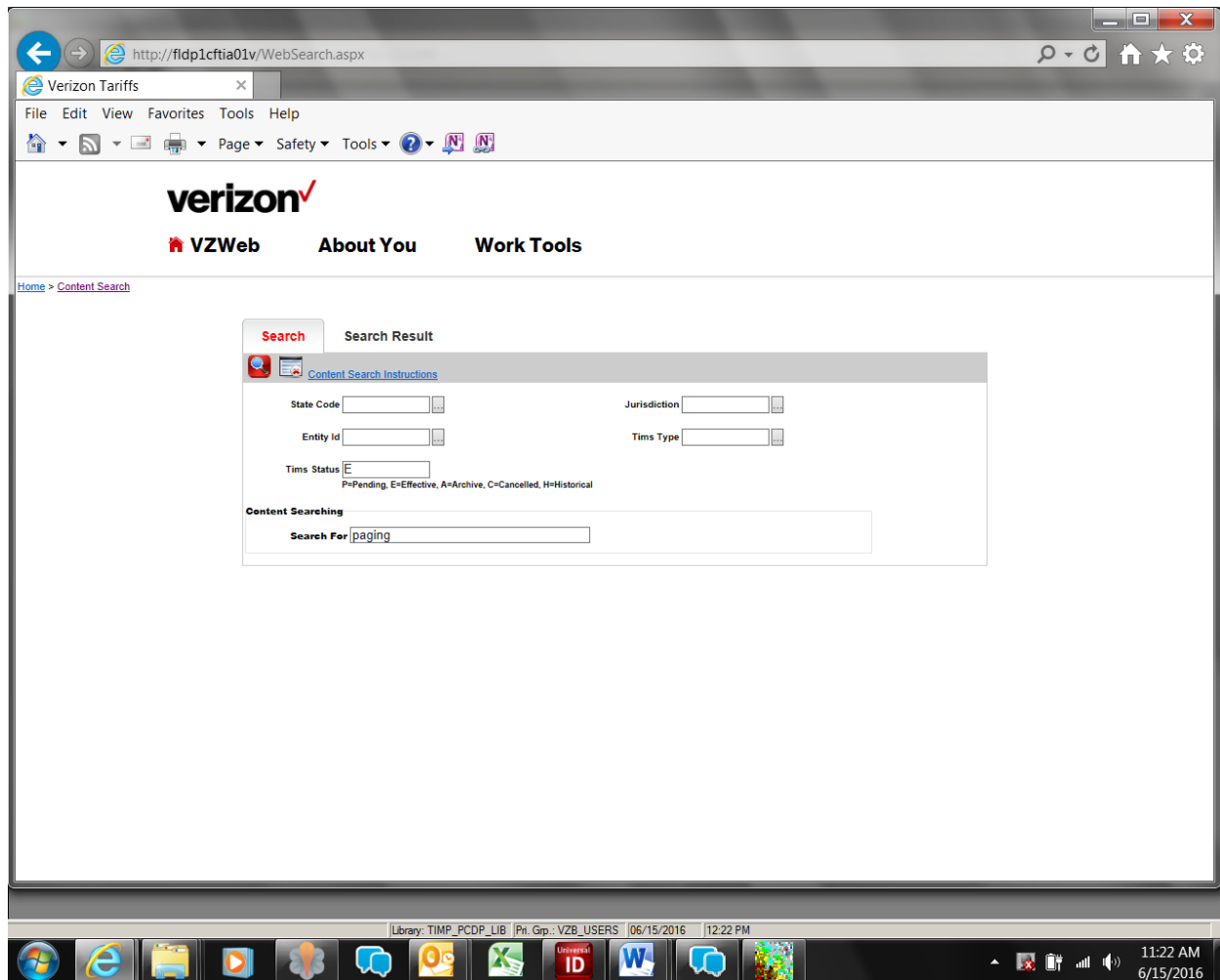

 - A.** An access order is used by the Telephone Company to provide the services offered under this tariff. The access order related charges specified in this section are in addition to other charges applicable for specific service offerings set forth in other sections of this tariff.
 - B.** The customer shall supply all the information necessary for the Telephone Company to provide and bill for the requested service, [e.g., customer name and premises location, billing name and address (when different from customer name and address), customer end user contact and premises location, facility interface, etc.].
 - C.** Any number of services of the same type and between the same premises may be ordered on a single access order.
 - D.** All details for a particular order must be identical except for those for multipoint service.
 - E.** All NXX assignment and administration shall be in accordance with the NANP. Assignment(s) will be made by the NANP coordinator.
- 3.1.2 Critical Dates**
 - A.** Certain Telephone Company critical dates are associated with an access order. The customer is advised of the critical dates associated with the access order on the date the order is entered in the Telephone Company's order distribution system. These dates are used by the Telephone Company to monitor the progress of the provisioning process. At any point in the access order interval, the Telephone Company is able to determine which critical date was the last date passed and therefore can determine what percentage of the Telephone Company's provisioning costs have been incurred as of that critical date.
